

Full-time Behavior Therapist/Registered Behavior Technician (RBT)

REED Intensive Behavior Services (RIBS) is a clinic-based classroom designed to help students diagnosed with autism who cannot be served in less intensive settings due to severe challenging behavior.

As a RIBS Behavior Therapist, you will work closely with Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA) and Behavior Specialists to conduct assessment and treatment sessions for students who engage in challenging behaviors (e.g., aggression, self-injurious behaviors, property destruction). Behavior therapists support students during skill acquisition programming and leisure skills.

Join a team that is dedicated to helping children in need of these specialized services.

- Mentorship provided by BCBA and BCBA-D
- Receive specialized training on Functional Analysis and Treatment strategies
- Schedule is aligned with a school (i.e., M-F, 8:30-3:30, holiday and summer breaks)

Strong Candidates are graduate or undergraduate students in Applied Behavior Analysis or related fields (Psychology, Education, Social Work, Speech-and Language Pathology) with at least 1-year experience working with children and adolescents.
