REED Intensive Behavior Services (RIBS) is a clinic-based classroom designed to support students diagnosed with autism who cannot be served in less intensive settings due to severe challenging behavior.

As a RIBS BCBA you will work closely with the Senior Behavior Analyst and Director (BCBA-D) to conduct assessment and treatment sessions for students who engage in challenging behaviors (e.g., aggression, self-injurious behaviors, property destruction).

- Small caseload (1-2 students)
- Mentorship/Supervision provided by a senior BCBA and BCBA-D
- Receive specialized training in functional analysis and treatment strategies

- Schedule is aligned with a school (i.e., M-F, 8:30-3:30, holiday and summer breaks)

- Master's degree from a regionally accredited college or university in Applied Behavior Analysis, Psychology or Special Education
